

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

## Piggy Bank Design Contest Official Rules

One (1) Entry per person during the Contest period.

Must be submitted by: November 2nd, 2023 to the Marion County Extension Office. Each Entry must be accompanied

by an official Entry Forms are

available at the office.

**Entry Requirements** 

Entries must meet the following requirements to be eligible for judging:

a. The bank <u>cannot</u> exceed 12 inches X 12 inches X 12 inches (1 square foot) b. Piggy banks
must be able to
hold coins (i.e.,
include a slot
that has been cut
to insert coins).

c. Piggy banks

must be created

or decorated by

the youth

contestant.

d. Plastic or ceramic banks or piggy banks may be used, but must be personally decorated

e. Piggy banks

DO NOT have

to be in the

shape of a pig.

f. You MAY
use or
repurpose
other
containers.





## Pumpkin Pie in a Bag

### Ingredients:

- 181/3 cup cold milk
- (2) 4 ox box of vanilla pudding
- (1) 15 oz can of pumpkin
- I teaspoon of cinnamon
- 1/2 teaspoon of ginger
- Graham crackers
- Whip cream

### Prepare:

- Pour milk and boxes of vanilla pudding into a ziplock bag & remove air.
- Squeeze and knead the bag for one minute.
- Add the can of pumpkin, cinnamon and ginger to the ziplock bag.
   Remove air.
- Squeeze and knead the bag until everything is blended.
- Set aside.
- Put Graham crackers into another ziplock bag and crush them with a rolling pin.
- In a Dixie cup put 1-2 Tablespoons of crushed graham crackers.
- Cut a hole in the corner of the pumpkin/pudding mix and squeeze some into the cup on top of the graham crackers.
- Put a dollop of whipped cream on top.
- Enjoy!
